Quebec City Embarkation Details:

Quebec City is one of the oldest cities in Canada and has a distinct old-world character and charm.

It is the only remaining walled city in North America north of Mexico and was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1985. This city is famous for its narrow cobblestone streets, stone buildings, fortifications, and rich culture. With a tremendous reputation for its quaint restaurants and cafes, this city will take you back in time while you enjoy the scenic views of the St. Lawrence River. Quebec City is bound to be an unforgettable experience for all who visit!

*Please note: You may drop your bags off at the dock starting at 3:00 pm. Boarding does not commence until 5:30 pm.

Dock Location:

Quai Renaud. Louise Basin/Bassin Louise. The docks here are in a holding basin regulated by a small lock.

Closest Address is 150 Rue Dalhousie.

Helpful Hint: Put "150 Rue Dalhousie" into your phone's map app.

The dock is directly west of this location. Cross the street and start traveling west on the boardwalk until the ship comes into view.

Taxi Services in Quebec City:

When Coming From the Train Station:

The Via Rail Station is located at 450 rue de la Gare du Palais, Quebec

- 1. Exit on Gare du Palais
- 2. Head South on Rue de la Gare du Palais
- 3. As you drive, Rue de La Gare will turn into Rue Abraham-Martin.
- 4. After approx 500m, turn left onto Quai Sainte Andre
- 5. Turn left onto Rue Dalhousie
- 6. Destination will be on the left.

There is a paved walking path towards docks

Whole trip is approx. 1km (.06 miles), 15 -20 minute walk and is a pedestrian friendly route.

When Coming from the Airport:

The Quebec City airport is located at 505 Rue Principale, Quebec

- 1. Exit the airport by turning right onto Airport Road (Route de l'Aeroport)
- 2. Merge onto the Autoroute 40E via the ramp towards Quebec City
- 3. Continue on Autoroute 40 E, and it will become Autoroute 440E
- 4. Stay on this road into the downtown core until it becomes Rue Saint-Paul
- 5. Turn right onto Quai Saint-Andre
- 6. Turn left onto Rue Dalhousie
- 7. Destination will be on the left.

There is a paved walking path towards docks

Whole trip is approx. 18km (11.2 miles), 20 minute car ride and this route is not pedestrian friendly.

When Coming from Hilton Quebec City:

Hilton Quebec is located at 1100 Boulevard Rene-Levesque E, Quebec

- 1. Exit the hotel turn left to head northeast on Boulevard Rene Levesque Est
- 2. Turn left onto Avenue Honoré-Mercier N/QC-175 N
- 3. Follow Avenue Honoré-Mercier N to Côte de la Potasse
- 4. Turn right on Côte de la Potasse to Côte Dinan
- 5. Turn left onto Côte Dinan
- 6. Turn right onto Quai Saint-Andre
- 7. Turn left onto Rue Dalhousie
- 8. Destination will be on the left. There is a paved walking path towards docks Whole trip is approx. 2.3km (1.4miles), 10 minutes by car.

When Coming from Manoir Victoria:

Manoir Victoria is located at 44 Cote du Palais, Quebec

- 1. Exit hotel and head northwest on Côte du Palais toward Rue Charlevoix
- 2. Slight right onto Côte Dinan
- 3. Turn right onto Quai Saint-André
- 4. Turn left onto Rue Dalhousie
- 5. Destination will be on the left. There is a paved walking path towards docks Whole trip is approx. 1.2km (.75 miles), 5 – 6 minutes by car.
