

### **Kingston Embarkation Details:**

Kingston is the home port of the Canadian Empress.

It is a city where history meets a lively and active community.

Kingston offers stunning views of the waterfront and charming limestone architecture, and the city is the perfect getaway for adventure and relaxation.

Please note: You may drop your bags off at the dock starting at 1pm. Boarding does not commence until 5:30pm.

#### Driving from the Via Rail Station,

located at 1800 John Counter Blvd Kingston, ON.

- 1. Turn left onto John Counter Blvd. to Princess St.
- 2. Turn left onto Princess St. and continue for 7km to downtown.
- 3. Turn right on Ontario St. and continue one block.
- 4. Arrive at Crawford Dock behind the Confederation Hotel
- \*The whole trip is approx. 7km (4.5 miles).

About 15-18 minutes and is not pedestrian friendly.

#### Driving from Highway 401 in either direction:

- 1. At exit 613, **Sydenham Rd.**, turn south and continue 2km to Princess St. *or* At exit 617, **Division St.**, turn south and continue 4km to Princess St. *or* At exit 619, **Montreal St.**, turn south and continue 5km to Princess St.
- 2. Turn left onto Princess St. and continue downtown to Ontario St.
- 3. Turn right on Ontario St. and continue one block.
- 4. Arrive at Crawford Dock behind the Confederation Hotel

or At exit 615, Sir John A MacDonald Blvd., continue south to Johnson St.

- 1. Turn left on Johnson St. and continue to Ontario St. and turn left.
- 2. Arrive at Crawford Dock behind the Confederation Hotel St.

### Long-Term Parking in Kingston, Ontario

St. Lawrence Cruise Lines is not responsible for lost or stolen items while parking in these lots.

We do not own these lots, therefore they are just recommendations based on their close proximity to where the Canadian Empress is docked.

If you have a larger vehicle (trailer, RV, etc.) please contact the lots directly to confirm.

### P1 Kingston Via Rail Train Station - Open Air Parking:

Parking here may require you to download Indigo Parking app - minimum 2 days. Parking prices range from \$16 CAD - \$115 CAD (up to a week). Parking can be done through the app or paid at the automated kiosk in the lot. Anything after a week, you have to pay for more time in the Indigo Parking app. You can add a Visa, MasterCard, Google Pay account or debit directly into the app. You cannot pay for parking inside the train station, as they will not accept payment and they do not have a system to pay at the meters. It is all done through the app only.

Short taxi ride away, about \$25 CAD per trip. (7km/4.5 miles) Electric Car Charging port? YES

# P Kingston Marriott- Underground Parking:

Enter from Clarence Street between Ontario Street and King Street.

Take a ticket on your way into the garage from the machine and park.


Take the ticket with you and keep it safe during your travels. At the end of your trip, you must pay at the front desk of the hotel before going down to your car.

The price for overnight parking is \$40 CAD every 24/ hours.

You do not need to pre-arrange for parking in this lot.

Parking lot entrance is just to the left of the hotel main doors. Take a ticket on your way into the lot, park, and pay at the meter on your way out. Meter will take Visa or MasterCard only. The price for overnight parking is \$40 CAD every 24/ hours. You do not need to pre-arrange for parking in this lot. Please note: if there is a sign that says LOT FULL or HOTEL GUESTS ONLY you must find another place to park amongst the other options on the list. Please plan accordingly.

This is an unmonitored public parking lot. It is available for overnight parking through the City of Kingston only. To make arrangements call the city at 613-549-0000, ext. 2 OR email <a href="mailto:parkingadmin@cityofkingston.ca">parkingadmin@cityofkingston.ca</a> to set up your overnight parking permit. You MUST say you are sailing with St. Lawrence Cruise Lines in order to receive the overnight permit. Allow 4-6 weeks for processing times.
